Walk in groups of two or more. Be encouraged to speak the Word of God over this campus as you walk.

“For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.” -Matthew 18:20; “So shall My Word be that goes out from My mouth; it shall not return to Me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.” -Isaiah 55:11; “Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given to you, just as I promised to Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun shall be your territory. - **That God’s children will walk in the fullness of their identity in Christ and in the center of His Will and that He may move in love, power, and wisdom through His Spirit and His people for His glory and His Kingdom**

“For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.” -2 Timothy 1:7; “The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.” -Psalm 29:11; “But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.” - 1 Peter 2:9; “And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.” -Colossians 1:9-12

and addiction in this community. That the Lord will silence every lie of the enemy in Jesus Name. That all witchcraft and sorcery will be broken and have no power over this school and that every fiery arrow of the evil one will be diverted in Jesus Name

“A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on all of God’s armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. Therefore, put on every piece of God’s armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God’s righteousness. For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere” -Ephesians 6:10-18

- **For the body of Christ to come together in unity and with His wisdom and that the Holy Spirit will provide vision and breathe life into programs and resources for the community. That the Lord will provide godly partnerships.**
